Greenblatt Fund President Honored for Service to Public Education

Dr. Marshal Greenblatt recognized by Montgomery County Board of Education

Potomac, MD – May 2, 2019 – The Marian Greenblatt Education Fund today announced that Fund President, Dr. Marshal Greenblatt, was selected by the Montgomery County Board of Education for its Distinguished Service to Public Education award. Greenblatt received an Individual Pioneer award for his efforts, through the Fund, to recognize and encourage outstanding teachers and students in Montgomery County.

“Usually I am the one giving awards, not receiving them,” said Greenblatt. “I’m proud of the work we have done to support public education in Montgomery County. When we started the Marian Greenblatt Education Fund 31 years ago, I always dreamed that it would make a meaningful difference in our community. I’m touched that the Board of Education recognizes these efforts.”

The Montgomery County Board of Education established the Awards for Distinguished Service to Public Education in order to recognize individuals, groups, and businesses that have made outstanding contributions to public education in Montgomery County. The Individual Pioneer Award is presented to an individual who has made extraordinary contributions to public education and whose impact has had a profound systemwide effect on Montgomery County Public Schools.

The Marian Greenblatt Education Fund is a 501c(3) non-profit organization established in 1988 to honor the memory of Dr. Marian Greenblatt, a leader in education and education policy in Montgomery County. Since its inception, the Fund has awarded more than \$175,000 to outstanding teachers and students. In addition to its annual Master Teacher and Rising-Star Teacher awards, the Fund presents awards for student excellence in Social Studies and in Foreign Languages.
